Subject: Clarification Regarding Forms for Dealer-to-Dealer Reassignments

Dear South Carolina Licensed Motor Vehicle Dealers,

The South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles (SCDMV) would like to clarify the preferred forms for dealer-to-dealer vehicle reassignments in light of recent updates published in the Spring 2025 *Dealer Connection*.

Effective May 1, 2025, the SCDMV—working in partnership with the South Carolina Automobile Dealers Association (SCADA) and the Carolina Independent Automobile Dealers Association (CIADA)—released the **Dealer Reassignment Form (DRA-001)** to standardize the process of vehicle title reassignments between dealers. This form is specifically designed to preserve the continuity and integrity of vehicle title chains during transfers within the dealer network.

The DRA-001 is the preferred document for all dealer-to-dealer reassignments and should be utilized to ensure consistent documentation and title processing.

However, to support continued operational flexibility during this transition period, **the following forms may still be used for dealer-to-dealer reassignment purposes**—provided they meet the transactional context and signature requirements:

• Form 4031 – Secured Bill of Sale

Intended for use when the title is unavailable due to lienholder possession or loss. This form includes odometer disclosure and may be used as a reassignment document when appropriately completed.

• Affidavit & Notification of Sale of Motor Vehicle ("PTO") Typically used to notify a sale and defer property tax prior to registration, this affidavit may also serve a supporting role in reassignment documentation, when applicable.

Please note: while these alternate forms remain acceptable at this time, dealers are encouraged to transition to the **DRA-001** as standard practice for all dealer-to-dealer vehicle reassignments. The form can be obtained through SCADA or CIADA.

We appreciate your continued attention to proper documentation and thank you for supporting a more efficient and accurate vehicle titling process in South Carolina.
