South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles CDL Waiver Application for Military Personnel Information Sheet

While other states or jurisdictions provide similar versions of this application, the South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles (SCDMV) only recognizes Form DL-408A as an application for waiver of Commercial Driver's License (CDL) requirements. This form may only be completed by a service member currently on active status or within 12 months of discharge date whose military duties required the operation of a military motor vehicle equivalent to a Commercial Motor Vehicle (CMV). Form DL-408A must be completed and signed by the service member and his or her Commanding Officer (pay grade O-4 or above) and is valid for 90 days from the Commanding Officer's (CO) date of signature.

A qualified military service member may complete this application for one of two waivers described below. This program applies to the issuance of an initial CDL only and cannot be used for upgrades or restriction changes.

- I. Apply for a <u>CDL even exchange waiver</u> of the knowledge and CDL skills tests based on your military duty rating and your military commercial motor vehicle (CMV) training and experience. You must possess one of the following MOS/AFSC ratings: 88M, 14T, 92F; 2T1, 2F0, 3E2; 3531; or EO, and your CO must complete Step 3 of Form DL-408A. If your application is approved, you will not have to take the knowledge or CDL skills test. You must meet all the other CDL licensing requirements, and pay applicable fees before a CDL can be issued. This skills test waiver program does not apply to endorsements.
- II. Apply for a <u>CDL skills test waiver</u> based on your military CMV experience. You must have operated a military equivalent of a CMV for 3,000 miles or more during the 2-year period immediately preceding the date of application (if still on active duty), or from your military discharge date, but are not required to have possessed one of the specified MOS/AFSC ratings. Your CO must complete Step 4 of Form DL-408A and if your application is approved, you will not have to take the CDL skills test. You must pass the CDL knowledge test and meet all the other CDL licensing requirements, and pay applicable fees before a CDL can be issued.
- A. Requirements that must be met before the SCDMV can consider issuing you a waiver.
 - 1. You must hold a valid South Carolina driver's license.
 - 2. You must provide a photocopy of your **valid military** driver's license.
 - 3. You and your Commanding Officer (pay grade O-4) must complete and sign the *CDL Waiver Application for Military Personnel* (SCDMV Form DL-408A).
 - a) Step 2, on the second page, must be completed by the CO before proceeding to step 3.
 - b) Step 3 should only be completed by the CO if the service member has one of the MOS/AFSC ratings provided. Skip to step 4 if he or she does not have one of those ratings.
 - c) Step 4 should only be completed if the service member does not possess one of the specified MOS/AFSC ratings listed for Step 3.
 - 4. You must provide a copy of your Active Duty/Reservist Military ID Card or discharge document (DD-214, WD-AGO, DD-256, or NGB-22) that shows your characterization of service (dishonorable discharge does not qualify).
- B. Submit your completed and signed application, and military ID card or discharge document using one of the following:

- C. You will be notified by mail once your application is processed. If your application is approved, you must first meet all other requirements for the classification of commercial license you are seeking before the CDL can be issued, such as:
 - 1. Complete additional DMV forms required for a CDL.
 - 2. Declare the type of commerce in which you intend to operate.
 - 3. Provide a DOT Medical Examiner's Certificate, if applicable.
 - 4. If applicable, pass CDL knowledge tests.
 - Pass the vision screening administered in a DMV branch office or the CDL vision examination administered by a licensed eye care professional. Refer to the <u>Certificate of Vision Examination Instruction Sheet</u> (DMV Form 412-IS) on the SCDMV website: www.scdmvonline.com.
 - 6. Pay all applicable DMV fees.

If you do not meet all of the requirements listed on this document or if it cannot be verified, you will be required to pass the CDL knowledge and skills tests in addition to the items listed above to get a CDL.
