SC code of law 56-5-5670 specifies that a demolisher or secondary metals recycler who purchases or otherwise acquires a vehicle pursuant to this affidavit may NOT wreck, dismantle, demolish, or otherwise dispose of the vehicle until at least three business days after the transaction has taken place. The demolisher or secondary metals recycler must also verify with the Department of Motor Vehicles whether the vehicle has been reported stolen and MUST report the vehicle to the National Motor Vehicle Title Information System in compliance with federal laws and regulations at the time of the transaction or no later than the end of the day of the transaction.

A person who violates the provisions of this section for a first offense is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, must be fined not more than five hundred dollars for each offense not to exceed five thousand dollars for the same set of transactions or occurrences, or imprisoned for not more than sixty days, or both. For a second or subsequent offense, the person is guilty of a felony and, upon conviction, must be fined not more than one thousand dollars for each offense not to exceed ten thousand dollars for the same set of transactions or occurrences, or imprisoned for not more than three years, or both.
